Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), Tirau Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 21 Birmingham Street, Paraparaumu and known as The Bond Store, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Alcohol is only permitted to be sold, supplied or delivered on or from the premises authorised by the licence.
- 2. Only alcohol products manufactured by Tirau Limited may be sold under the licence.
- All deliveries of alcohol must be signed for by a person aged 18 years or older. Signs of intoxication on the part of the recipient would result in non-delivery.
- 4. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday - 8am to 10pm

- No alcohol may be sold on the premises or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- 6. Alcohol sold by remote sale may not be delivered at any time after 11pm on any day and before 6am on the next day.
- No single sale of beer or ready to drink spirits (RTDs) in bottles, cans or containers of 500mls or less in volume may occur
 except for craft beer.
- 8. The whole of the premises is designated as a **supervised** area.
- 9. Water must be freely available for drinking at all times alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- 10. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons.
- 11. The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the safe and responsible consumption of alcohol, and minimising alcohol related harm.
- 12. The licence, or a copy of the licence, must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises and on the website.
- 13. The licensed premises situated at 21 Birmingham Street, Paraparaumu are more precisely identified as outlined in the plan date stamped as approved by the District Licensing Committee on 2 July 2024 displayed alongside this licence and held on DLC file OFF885.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either-
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued
